The ApPEC Objectives (as approved by the ApPEC Steering Committee, January 10, 2010)

Strategic objectives

- Provide a discussion forum for the coordination of European ApP;
- Develop and update long term strategies (e.g. Roadmap for European ApP);

To accomplish its objectives, ApPEC, following the end of ASPERA, will need a renewed structure, with a budget and an office. We have proposed to keep the Association model, among those studied in ASPERA Deliverable 5.4

The discussion is first about the importance to involve responsible people at the highest level in ministries or funding agencies (i.e. INFN). The German proposal to establish a "Strategic Board" formed by signatories of a MoU/LoI is finally considered as "Mission Impossible". They would have "blessed" the creation and operation of ApPEC, the structure with the objectives defined above.

It is more realistic to add an ApPEC objective as "Trigger high level meetings when necessary", i.e. not to create an new "Council".

This idea will be summarized in a short document, sent to the ApPEC delegates for consultations and taken over by a Working Group of 3 ApPEC representatives.
