


# Agenda item 6: CHIPP Prize: revised procedure

- After three years of working with the present rules, the need to revise them slightly has been identified.
- Shortcomings: few applications, little involvement and interest of the Board Members in the selection process.
- Main changes:
  - ➤ PhD students may apply more than once → more applications
  - → deadline one month earlier and reduced paperwork → assessment
    of applications before the holiday period; increased motivation
  - → dedicated Selection Committee → selection is made by identifiable committee members, which leads to an increasingly professional selection.

The Board (applying Art. 27, litt. q) is requested to approve the revised procedure for the CHIPP Prize (simple majority).
