

## ACCU: Nomination of the Swiss representative

## Introduction

The decision regarding the Swiss representative in the Advisory Committee of CERN Users (ACCU) belongs to the CHIPP Plenary. The decision is taken on the basis of a recommendation of the Board.

## Proposal

Michele Weber has served for three two-year terms as ACCU representative from 2009 to 2014. He expressed the wish not to continue for another term next year. The call for nominations among the Board Members has resulted in only one candidate, Michael Dittmar, who is ready to serve in this function for the years 2015-2016. A brief CV of the candidate is attached.

The Board (in conformity with Article 19, litt. e) is requested

- to recommend to the Plenary the election of Michael Dittmar for a first two-year term from January 2015 to December 2016 as ACCU representative.

Required majority: simple

The CHIPP Chair will submit the name of the recommended candidate to the Plenary for decision.
