6. Round Table International: Preparation

The subjects for the Round Table International were reviewed. M. Bourquin will present future plans for ApPEC, he will seek approval for his draft Letter of Intent by the Round Table. The ICFA seminar is an important update for decision makers on medium- and long-term plans. L. Rivkin and KK will present talks. MP will ask SER to ensure a high level representation. U. Straumann will present news from the CTA RBB concerning finances and organisation. The problem of the CTA representation in the SER road map will be re-iterated. Upgrade plans for the LHC detectors will be discussed, approval will be sought for the proposal to extend the validity of the existing MoU. A decision on who signs the MoU extension will be requested. The difficult item of the Swiss representation in the European Grid Initiative, vital for LHC data analysis, will be discussed. The aim is to ask SWITCH to continue its coordinating role.

A draft program for the scientific part of the Leysin Plenary Meeting was discussed, with proposals for some speakers. All EB members will continue to draft participants from their laboratories and collaborating institutes.
