1. CHIPP elections

On recommendation by the CHIPP Board, two representations in international committees are proposed for election:

- Thomas Gehrmann (U.ZH) as Swiss representatives in the Restricted ECFA (starting on 1 January 2010):
 - ➔ Based on the recommendation of the CHIPP Board, the Plenary approves this appointment with an overwhelming majority (1 abstention).
- Terence Garvey (PSI) as Swiss representative in the Plenary ECFA (starting on 1 August 2009):
 - ➔ Based on the recommendation of the CHIPP Board, the Plenary approves this appointment with an overwhelming majority (1 abstention).

For future appointments, the Plenary wishes to see at least the CV of the candidate(s) beforehand.

2. CHIPP Prize Award 2009

The CHIPP Prize for the best PhD student in experimental or theoretical particle physics is awarded for the second time. Out of three candidates and following the procedure published on the CHIPP website, the CHIPP Board selected Pedro Schwaller from University of Zurich on the following grounds: *“For his deep understanding of quantum field theory and his original and important contributions in theoretical particle physics.”*

The Plenary is informed about this selection and the winner presents his current research activity.

3. Farewell to Ueli Straumann

The incoming chair, Martin Pohl, describes the present stable functioning of CHIPP and the fact that its voice is heard and listened to, as a real success story to which the outgoing chair, Ueli Straumann, has made a very important contribution. He thanks Ueli for his constructive way of chairing meetings and wishes him all the best for his work beyond the CHIPP chairmanship, which will end on 31 December 2009. Martin Pohl also includes Jean-Pierre Ruder as “Secretary General” of CHIPP in his thanks.
